## Scheduled Water Pressure Test Tuesday – October 23<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m.

Dear: Hilltop System Property Owner:

There is a planned test to switch over to the artesian / reservoir scheduled for Tuesday, October 23<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 10:00 a.m. You will most likely experience low water pressure. The hope is to draw any air gaps or air locks out of the system and to restore the normal water pressure. Water **WILL BE AVAILABLE** during this test period and we **WANT YOU TO USE AS MUCH WATER AS POSSIBLE** during this test period. We plan on running the test until the reservoir is almost empty 7500 gallons. Then we will switch back over to the new well / hydrostatic pump and let the reservoir fill up. During the test, we're hoping that the water pressure will increase back to the normal 40 psi.

During the test, we will be attaching hoses to easily accessible locations to create as much water demand as possible. If you do not want us to use any spigots or faucets on your property, or if you plan on using this test period to water outside vegetation on your own, simply notify me via email at [ghinouye1@gmail.com](mailto:ghinouye1@gmail.com) at least 24 hours prior to the test.

Please take the necessary steps to have adequate water available for your personal use during this outage in case you experience low or unusable water pressure.

For those of you who have elected electronic transmission, we will send out an email when the work is completed, and the water pressure is back to normal.
